

INSTRUCTIONS

- Loss of I-Card/Borrower Ticket should be reported to the librarian immediately.
- Issue of duplicate I-card as well as borrower ticket will be made available against due charges.
- Students can avail the facility of reference book / journals / periodicals within the library premises only against I-cards.
- A fine Rs.1/- day will be charged on late return of book issued on library borrower ticket .
- A fine Rs.5/- day will be charged on late return of book issued on I-card.
- Writing of scribbling on or tearing of pages of library book, news papers, periodicals etc. is prohibited & will be liable for strict action.
- Students should produce their identity cards as & when demanded by the library staff.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited inside the library.
