Brief Report:

After getting freedom from British Rule, the provinces and princely states were reorganised into the Union of India through the States Reorganization Act, 1956. The Act proposed the reorganization on the basis of the language spoken in a region. Initially, Bombay State was formed for people who spoke Marathi, Konkani, Gujarati, and Kutchi. Two significant groups emerged, those speaking Marathi and Konkani, and those who spoke Gujarati and Kutchi. They demanded to divide the Bombay State into two, by following many protests and demonstrations in support of the new state. To achieve this, the Bombay Reorganization Act was passed in the Parliament in April 1960. And on 1st May 1960 Maharashtra state is created, since that period we all are celebrating 1st May as Maharashtra Day every year. On 1st May, 2023, flag hoisting was taken by the hands of Shri. Anil patil Mhashakhetri, President, Shri. Shivaji Shikshan Prasark Mandal, Gadchiroli at 7.30 am. We all saluted our Tri-color National Flag followed by chorusing National Anthem.
